About us

The Oñati International Institute for the Sociology of Law (IISL) is an academically oriented non-profit organization that has the form of a private foundation with public governance. According to its Statutes, the IISL is dedicated to international scientific and technical research in the sociology of law and performs its functions mainly in the Basque Country.

The IISL was created in 1988 by representatives of the Basque Government and the Research Committee on Sociology of Law (RCSL) within the International Sociological Association. Its headquarters, central services, and library, specializing in sociology of law, are located in the Old University of Oñati. These spaces are provided by the Provincial Council of Gipuzkoa, one of three Provinces of the Basque Country. In addition, the IISL offers its users the possibility of staying at the Antía Residence, located in Plaza Santa Marina, No. 5, in the heart of Oñati. This is a historical building dating back to the 18th century, which is owned by the municipality of Oñati.

The IISL is closely linked to other public institutions of the Basque Country, such as the University of the Basque Country (UPV/EHU) and the Basque Foundation for Science, Ikerbasque. The IISL Scientific Director is affiliated with both institutions, and the IISL organizes an International Master's Programme in Sociology of Law for the UPV/EHU.

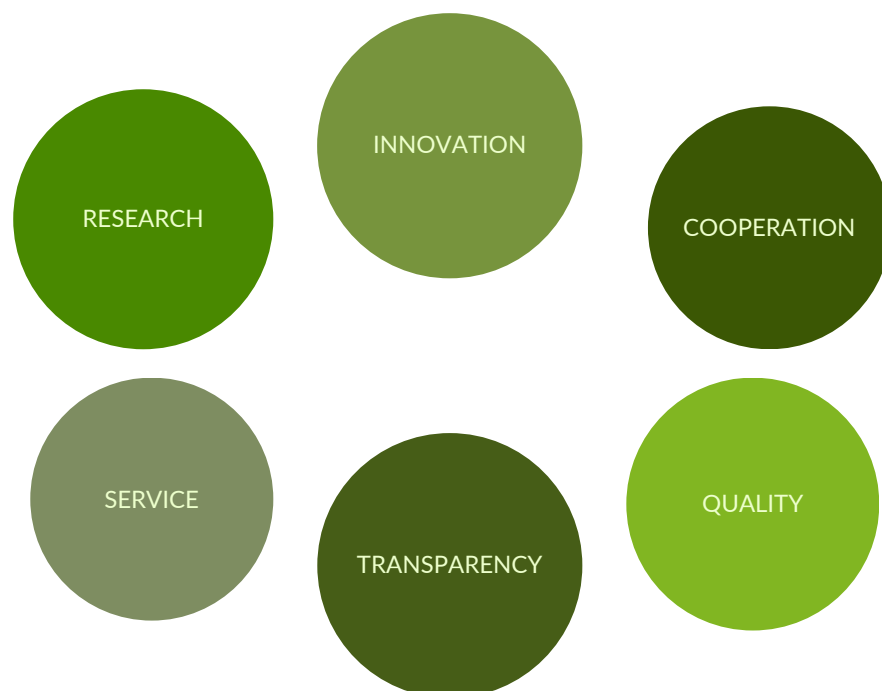
Mission

LIBRARY

DESCRIPTION

The IISL library and documentation centre, inaugurated in 1989 and specialized in sociology of law, is open to all users of the IISL as well as the interested public and can be accessed for free.

It uses its own classification system for books along the core topics and subfields of the sociology of law. This allows researchers to easily locate the sections of their interest. Given direct access to the physical collections in the library, they can conveniently skim through relevant books and browse through the materials in the adjacent shelves.

More than 22,000 volumes can be consulted on site, together with extensive collections of journals on the sociology of law and other related subjects.

The catalogue contains more than 119,000 references of books, chapters in collective works, journal articles and electronic documents.

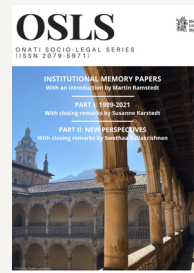

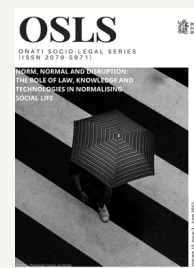

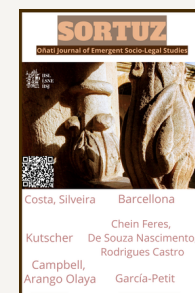

DESCRIPTION

The International Master in Sociology of Law is an Official Master of the University of the Basque Country (UPV/EHU), taught in English and affiliated with UPV/EHU's Faculty of Law.

PROGRAMME

The International Master in Sociology of Law is a one-year programme that offers an advanced training in sociology of law and socio-legal research. It is taught by professors and researchers who are internationally recognized for their work in the sociology of law.

The Master is a research-oriented programme, which provides students with the conceptual foundations and methodological skills to undertake socio-legal research projects on their own. It includes a course period of six months with intensive classes (40 ECTS credits) and a period in which students focus on their own research and the writing of their Master's theses (20 ECTS credits).

As an internationally oriented programme, the Master is not limited to specific national or regional contexts, but takes the comparative, international and global dimensions of socio-legal problems seriously.

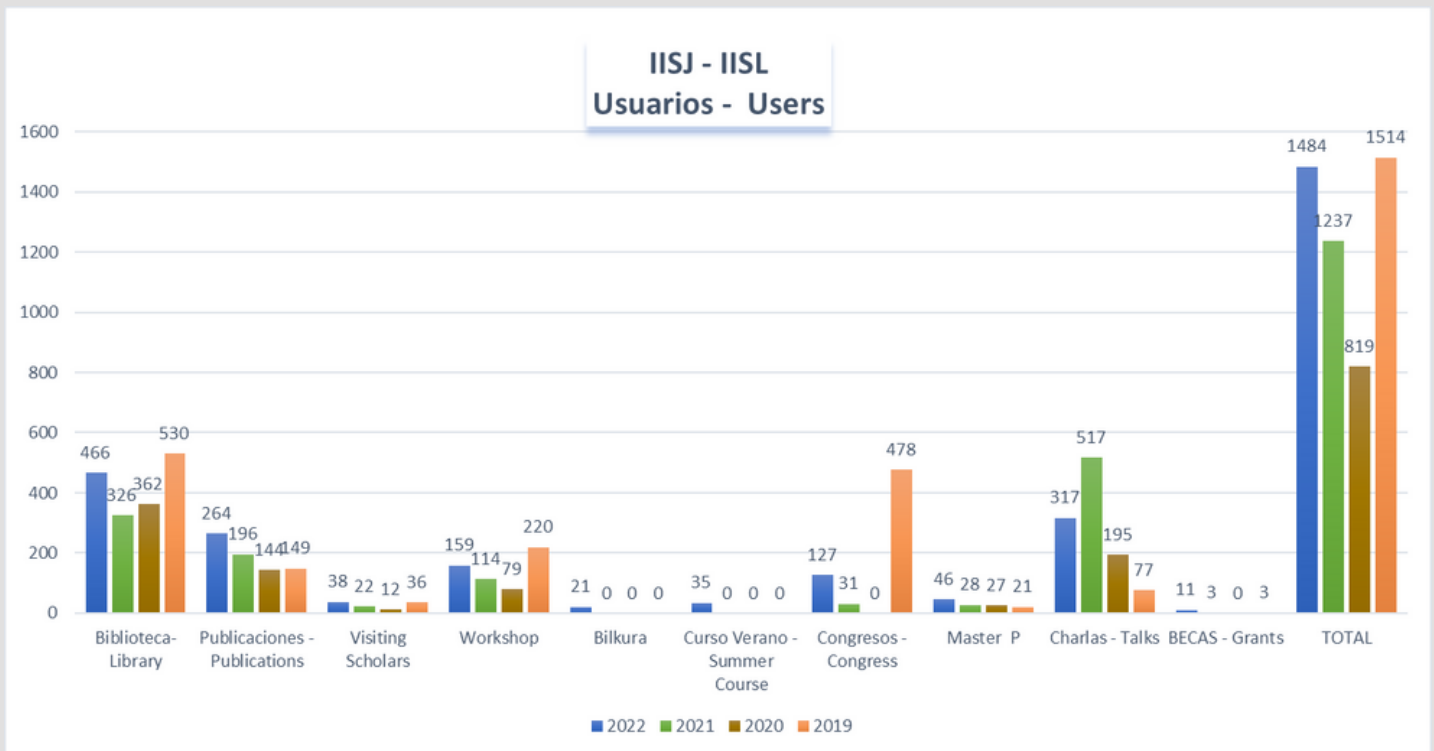
