MANOLO CALVO PRIZE

Prof. Manuel (Manolo) Calvo García (1956-2020) was Full Professor of Philosophy of Law and Sociology of Law at the University of Zaragoza, and Scientific Director of the Oñati International Institute for the Sociology of Law (2002-2003). He was the author of a relevant and very innovative scientific body of work, in which he combined the attention to general aspects of Theory of Law and Sociology of Law with applied research. On his death, members of the Oñati Community (OC) generously donated to keep his scientific legacy and the OC decided to set up a Committee to organise a special award carrying his name through the IISL.

A special prize of 500 € will be awarded to the best Master's thesis, in any of the official languages of the Institute, each academic year when the subject of the thesis is related to any of Manolo Calvo's lines of research or work, such as:

- the effectiveness of law in various areas of social law and human rights,
- equality and gender violence,
- the protection of children and adolescents,
- juvenile justice,
- protection of the most disadvantaged,
- democratic participation,
- Social rights in the European framework, with a focus on the marginalized,
- immigration and migrants,
- juvenile offenders,
- public policies and social rights,
- security policies,
- transformations and changes in the law.

These two requirements will be taken into account:

- The quality of the Master's thesis
- The approach must be empirical and not purely theoretical.

Tribunal:

Composed of Teresa Picontó, Joxerramon Bengoetxea and Vincenzo Ferrari.

The prize will be awarded in October 2022, when the theses are delivered, defended and evaluated. The awarding of the prize will be announced on 10.10.2022.
